Executive Update - Matt McFarlane, Executive Director
☐ Strong start to the school year; climate, culture, and energy in the building is positive. Initial
parent feedback has been positive.
☐ Initial student numbers are around 359, which is lower than the past few years. This is below
our budget ADM of 365, but is manageable.
☐ The freshman class is exceptionally small at 53 students. PiM should do what is
necessary to prevent this downturn from becoming a trend.
Outreach events planned for this year include the PiM Pop-up at the Eden
Prairie Center and events focused on current middle school students.
☐ Would like to see ADM's increase rather than decrease over the course of
2024-25
A series of articles published in the Star Tribune recently provided a one-sided and critical

perspective on charter schools in Minnesota, despite a large body of interviews conducted

with charter school advocates and administrators for these interviews. PiM co-wrote a response with Paladin Career and Tech School and Eagle Ridge Academy that was published
